Fees -

Includes practices, gym fees, choreography, music, practice gear, uniforms, warm-ups, backpack & event registration fees. Any travel and room/board is OYO. Postseason fees with D2 SUMMIT or The Summit Regional will be separate. New this year - Parents will register required USASF membership on their own according to USASF new requirements. Instructions for parents will be provided via email and double checked by our office after tryouts. Total inclusive regular season package - \$3,890. An initial fee of \$670 due September 1st covers uniform, warm-up jacket and backpack. Monthly Fees of \$460 will be due every 15th of the month, Sept 15 - March 15, a total of 7 payments. Returning members' initial fee will be less the cost of warm-up and/or warm-up jacket if those items aren't needed.
